



CBI MEDICAL & ANTIDOPING COMMISSION RECOMMENDATION

DRUG FREE AND ANTIDOPING

This event is classified within the CBI calendar as a 'Sanctioned Event', classification that includes both compliance with international WADA standards and application of the CBI regulation for classified events "Clean Event" in the terms defined by both WADA and the specific CBI Regulations including the approval of the Records.

Failure to apply this setting automatically leads for the athlete and/or team and/or organizer to penalties of a sporting, civil and/or criminal nature in accordance with the legislation of the country hosting the event.

All athletes taking drugs for specific, diagnosed illnesses must have a valid TUE (Therapeutic Use Exemption) document issued in accordance with WADA standards and accepted by the CBI Medical & Antidoping Commission (compliance@cbi-prv.org).

The implementation of Drug Free Controls is also required by the CBI technical regulations for the confirmation of World and Continental records. Controls and evaluation for this purpose can be carried out by either DCO (Doping Control Officer) or CBI qualified personnel using official kit and following antidoping sampling procedures.

In the event of an adverse outcome or failure in the procedure, the result will not be confirmed.

MEDICAL EMERGENCIES

In view of the size and importance of the CBI event, as well as the age and promiscuity of the athletes' interactions, it is necessary for the Organizing Committee to pay special attention to the management of medical aspects, also in view of the continuing level of COVID and other epidemic contest.

All teams and personnel involved, including volunteers, should have access to information and recommendations that should be shared and coordinated to ensure a coordinated operational response.

Medical emergencies services should be provided for the period of the event through a collaboration with the Turkish Red Crescent, and will be active from October 22nd to 28th, 2024.

To ensure prompt response and coordination with outside medical facilities, a medical post should be operational during the entire event.

External public facilities and hospitals will deliver H24 emergency medical services.

MEDICAL INSURANCE AND ACCIDENT INSURANCE FOR THE EVENT

The Turkish Red Crescent will provide emergency medical assistance service throughout the competition as part of the Organizing Committee's coverage for all participants in this event.

Private insurance coverage should be strongly considered for accidents that necessitate specific services or treatment, like medical care, that are not covered by the Organizing Committee.

CARRYING MEDICINE IN A HANDBAG

At check-in / custom security checks, medicaments must be presented in a closed transparent bag, liquids contained in individual containers of a capacity not exceeding 100 ml, accompanied by package leaflet and medical prescription.

Athletes and/or accompanying persons must comply with the regulations in force in both the country of origin and the country where the event is held, if they need to transport drugs based on narcotic substances or psychotropic substances, including those for their own therapeutic needs,

These procedures provide, for the citizen who needs to travel abroad and continue therapy with drugs or psychotropic drugs, possession of a specific medical certificate, Issued by the general practitioner or the doctor of the Medical Health Service.

In both cases, the doctors must be identifiable and reachable for any confirmation/assessment.
